Students in HA 510 will study the history of the book from 300 to 1500 C.E., concentrating on the role of visual imagery in books and the place of books in medieval and renaissance culture. We'll consider methods of book production, the development of new cycles of illustration for religious and secular books, and the relationship between manuscripts and early printed books. We will use the fine collection of manuscripts, printed books, and facsimiles in the Kenneth Spencer Research Library as an integral part of the course.
